Four Observations from 1 Samuel 23:14–18

1 Samuel 23:14-18

David stayed in the wilderness strongholds and in the hills of the Desert of Ziph. Day after day Saul searched for him, but God did not give David into his hands. **15** While David was at Horesh in the Desert of Ziph, he learned that Saul had come out to take his life. **16** And Saul's son Jonathan went to David at Horesh and helped him find strength in God. **17** "Don't be afraid," he said. "My father Saul will not lay a hand on you. You will be king over Israel, and I will be second to you. Even my father Saul knows this." **18** The two of them made a covenant before the Lord. Then Jonathan went home, but David remained at Horesh.

4. What are some ideas you have to help "even up the balance"? (some of us need to be willing to receive more support from others and some of us need to look for ways to give more support to others.)

5. Jonathan was a great support to David because ultimately he helped David find his strength in God. What are some specific ways we can help others find strength in Christ? (Write down any Scripture references that are helpful in answer to this question for further reflection and/or discussion.)
